

The Flying Dutchman

“The Flying Dutchman”-is a full service support barge to host events and openings on the River. Based on a barge form, the flexible design allows sophisticated support that rivals shore based services, leveraging the allure of the water. Shallow draft and the stable foot print allows support to be provided in areas with minimal depth as little as 3-5 feet. Integrating a river kayak race, evening social or showcase, the latest design in fashion; all can be supported.

Like the Ghost ship, the system is mobile and can be deployed through out the Eastern United States River system and canals. This provides a 12 month system which can have the vessels work the east coasts in spring and early summer, migrate to the Midwest and Mississippi basing in the summer and fall and winter through gulf and Caribbean.

With a 6 week refit period in March and April, the “Flying Dutchman” will be kept up to date with latest presentation AV support and accommodations. Whether stand alone, working with the Ghost Ship or other event elements, this platform provides a new level of sophistication to expose sponsors to a wide cross section people and be “a must see” in the media and a “will use” for any event promoter looking to have that needed edge.
